

Community Marker (Totems) Installation

At the April 21, 2007 First Annual Westgate Spring Festival, the CRA hired Public Artist Sharon Koskoff to do a ceramic tile workshop with the children in the community. The workshop included the creation of a public artwork by the participants to be used as a community marker specified by the CRA Redevelopment Plan. The community marker consists of three totem poles of different heights representing the unique characteristics of Westgate/Belvedere Homes area and the family unit: Father, Mother, and Child.

With the help of New Country Motor Cars of Palm Beach, LLC, (NCMC) the owner of the Mercedes Benz dealership located at the northeast corner of Indian Road and Westgate Avenue, a visible site has been located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Westgate Avenue and Indian Road. The CRA, together with business community partners consisting of NCMC, C.R. Dunn Inc., Electrical Contractors, Autobuilders General Contracting Services, Inc., and FPL, and the design teams of Municipal Lighting, RCL Engineering, and Sharon Koskoff have contributed either through in-kind services and/or reduced fees to make this small but significant project a reality.
