

Westgate Avenue Streetscape



Project Funding and Cost

Estimated Cost \$3,000,000

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The study will cover a mid block point between Indian and Wabasso Drives eastward to a mid-block point between Loxahatchee and Suwanee Drives, comprising five intersections and 4,110 linear feet (LF) of Westgate Avenue, two links of Nokomis and Cherokee Avenues from Tallahassee to Osceola totaling 5,480 LF, two 885 LF links of Tallahassee and Loxahatchee Drives including four intersections, two of which will be proposed as “roundabouts”, two 670 LF links of Seminole and Osceola Drives including four more intersections, 100 LF of Wabasso either side of Westgate Avenue. In total, 12,900 LF of roadway and 12 intersections will be affected and included within the scope of the project. The concept plans will be developed for approval by Palm Beach County as it relates to traffic volume and circulation, and urban design.

In addition to the traffic facilitation and calming aspects of the project, the streetscape will be designed to enhance the pedestrian environment and encouraging alternative modes of transportation by incorporating decorative street lights, public art, landscaping, mass transit stops and shelters and on-street parking.

The project is currently in the planning/design phase.



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
